
Library is Closed: Monday, February 16

Volunteers from the AARP will be at the library Mondays and Saturdays through April 13 to help seniors and low to moderate income taxpayers of all ages with their federal returns.

Tax assistance volunteers do not help prepare Schedule C over \$10,000 in



expenses, Schedule E, complicated/lengthy Schedule D forms without proper paperwork or other specialized forms. Taxpayers with complex forms are advised to seek paid tax help.
